#### **CATHOLIC FAITH CORNER**

A Year of the Holy Spirit (The Gift of Piety)



As we conclude our look at the Gift of Piety in a series of all the gifts of the Holy Spirit, the best way to cultivate the gift of piety is to pray the Our Father with reverence and devotion, taking time to meditate on the different petitions. A worthwhile endeavor is to read Catechism of the Catholic Church's explication on the Our Father, (CCC, Nos. 2759- 2865). As the catechism notes, in this prayer one finds "the summary of the whole Gospel."

A second way is to sanctify our work, meaning to be mindful that whatever we do can be made into an offering to the Lord, whether out of pure devotion, or for the poor souls in purgatory, or the reparation for our own sins. Again, as a child, I remember the sisters at St. Bernadette School saying, "Offer it up," when we kids would complain about the heat or something else. Now as an adult, when I empty the dishwasher — which I detest — I always say to myself, "Lord, this is for the poor souls." Piety truly can help us endure the most distasteful of tasks. Where there is love, there is no labor.

In summary, Pope Francis taught, "Piety, therefore, is synonymous of authentic religious spirit, filial confidence in God, of the capacity to pray to Him with love and simplicity which is proper of persons who are humble of heart. The gift of piety makes us grow in our relationship and communion with God and leads us to live as His children; at the same time, it helps us to pour this love also onto others and to recognize them as brothers and sisters."

Faith Action for Community Equity is a 501(c)3 non-profit currently comprised of 16 Oahu interdenominational Christian churches and two community groups. Annually, members are asked to "invest" in Faith Action's work through donations of any amount.

Since 1995, Faith Action has focused on addressing the systemic inequities that affect our neighbors. Faith Action works with community groups, neighborhood boards, the city council, and the state legislature. We write, speak, and stand up to make the voice of faith heard by decisionmakers.

Examples of needs we have worked on:

*Met decades ago:* Bus shelters were built. Kalihi Valley residents got safe sidewalks for their neighborhood. Long-neglected Kalihi Valley Housing was renovated. Kukui Gardens apartments were saved for low income renters.

*Needs partially met:* In 2018, the legislature established modest financial support to assist family members caring for Kupuna from low to moderate income families. Also in 2018, the "Bob Nakata Act" significantly increased funds available to help make housing rentals more affordable. This legislative session, minimum wage for Hawaii's workers was moved an inch closer to a living wage.

Still out of reach: Truly affordable housing for working families that make \$80,000 or less a year. Studies indicate 30% of our homeless are working families.

Imminent needs: We are visible in protecting Oahu's endangered drinking water, vital to all life.


