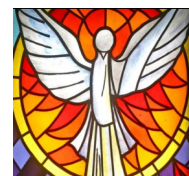
ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY

CATHOLIC FAITH CORNER

A Year of the Holy Spirit (The Gift of Counsel)



The Gift of Counsel is especially necessary for giving others direction and giving ourselves discrimination. Who needs the Gift of Counsel? Everybody! Especially, Bishops, Priests, and Superiors. Without this Gift, there is no assurance of doing what God wants. Without the Gift of Counsel, there would be nothing but confusion.

What is lacking is our obtaining God’s grace and then using the grace that Christ won for us by his death on Calvary. Two free wills redeem the world. First, the free will of Christ, who became man to have a free will, and then the submission of our free will to His will.

The Gift of Counsel is necessary in the more important decisions of life. There is need for discrimination. We must depend more than ever before, on the Gift of the Holy Spirit to counsel us. To tell us what we should do in a given situation. This includes the assurance that what we are doing is pleasing to God. Nothing is more important than to depend on the Holy Spirit. Consult Him; ask Him, "What should I do." And then trust Him!

The deepest decisions of our lives are not external decisions. "What kind of work do I do? Or how should I do it?" The deepest decisions are deep down inside of our souls. And these are decisions which no human being can tell you what to do. There must be an intimacy with God; a closeness of the Holy Spirit. And living as much as we can in His presence, so that the decisions we make, interiorly, is not advice, the Holy Spirit does not give just advice. The Holy Spirit gives directives. And that is what we call the Gift of Counsel. In the last analysis, our first, principle and primary Spiritual Director, is the Holy Spirit.

How can we grow in this Gift of Counsel; first....develop deep personal humility. The more humble a person is, the more active and effective will be the Gift of Counsel. Never, never, cherish a self admiring thought. Never admire yourself in your own eyes. The mind is the most dangerous mirror. The most dangerous pride is how we look into ourselves. I admire myself....oh...how smart I must be!

Second...develop the sense of my own weakness and ignorance. You've got to grow in learning, realizing how stupid and weak we are! It takes time. How do we grow in this Gift of Counsel? We keep asking our Lord. "Show me Lord, your ways and teach me your paths". Keep asking our Lord. "Lord, tell me what to do next. What to think next". Because the most important part of our lives are our thoughts. Every thought, unless we control it, becomes a desire. Every desire, unless we control it, becomes an action.

SPOTLIGHT ON SERVICE

JODI BARNHART



Many of us enjoy making crafts – keeping our hands busy and our minds active. Even those of us who don't make crafts enjoy benefitting from the work of others. This was evident for many years here at St. John Vianney Parish when the Sodality of Our Blessed Lady would host its annual craft fair, raising thousands of dollars for the parish.

As the parish entered its sixth decade a few years back, it became clear that we no longer had a crew of crafters able to sustain such a major event. What to do? How could we continue to offer crafting opportunities and help our parish at the same time? Enter Jody Barnhart!

Jody joined our parish in 2018, moving to Hawaii with her husband Paul in order to be closer to their daughter. Jody joined the crafters' group and soon realized that she was facing a moment of opportunity. Jody had been a rosary-maker for 30 years, working primarily with metal rosaries. This is a task which requires much time and skill; but clearly results in blessings not only for the crafter, but also for the recipient of the rosary.

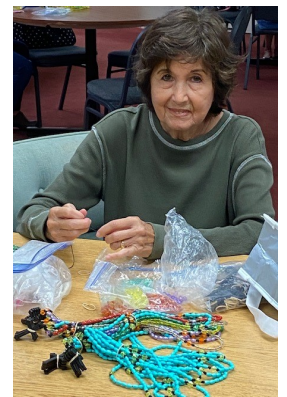
Jody wanted a way for our SJV crafters to share in such a special effort, but without the need for extensive training or costly equipment. The answer? Mission rosaries! These are made with plastic beads knotted on cord and can be completed in less than 30 minutes.

In February of 2019, Jody's two sisters came for a visit. She brought them to the crafters' meeting and the team of three offered the crafters an opportunity to learn rosary-making. The outcome? In the three years since that meeting, our SJV crafters have made more than 30,000 rosaries! Even through the pandemic, though they did not gather together, they continued to make rosaries. Some do it while watching TV. Others, while undergoing medical treatment. Still others, while traveling on the mainland.

Currently, the group has resumed meeting in person – Thursday mornings from 9–11 a.m. in the parish board room. There are approximately 20 members, though attendance on any given Thursday is likely to be 10-15 people. They create roughly 1,000 rosaries per month.

The finished rosaries have been delivered to every Catholic school on Oahu and hand carried to the neighbor islands with plans to eventually deliver to every Catholic church, as well. And in collaboration with an international organization called "Our Lady's Rosary Makers," the crafters have been able to send rosaries in response to requests from around the world.

Jody and her husband Paul have found great joy in their support of this effort. Does this opportunity speak to you? Can you see yourself as a rosary maker? If so, please stop by on any Thursday morning between 9–11 a.m. or contact Jody by leaving a message at the SJV parish office.
