### Holy Spirit Novena, May 10—18, 2024 (Ascension to Pentecost on May 19)

The Holy Spirit plays a BIG part in our lives. So, as we pray, ask the Holy Spirit for something concrete and measurable. Novenas are an ancient tradition that goes back to the days of the Apostles. Jesus told His disciples to pray together after his **ascension into heaven**, so they went to an upper room along with the Blessed Mother (Acts 1:14) and joined constantly in prayer for nine days. These nine days of constant prayer by the Apostles at the direction of Jesus led up to Pentecost when the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples as "tongues of fire" (Acts 2:1-4). This pattern of nine days of prayer, leading up to a feast day or final (10th) day, is the basis of the novenas we pray today! Thus, the novena is an imitation of the Lord's command to the Apostles when they prayed for nine days in anticipation of the coming of the Holy Spirit. ### EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL

#### Presence of Jesus in Adoration



**Prayers to Say During Adoration:** There is no exact "right" prayer (or way to pray) during Adoration. Adoration is about imitating God. Fr. Josh of Ascension Press puts it this way: *"We want to imitate our Savior, Jesus Christ. Any time we spend time with people, we become more like the people we hang out with. The more we spend time with Jesus, the more we're going to be like Jesus."*

Consider that as a starting point: Merely being with Christ in the Eucharist helps us draw closer to Him, regardless of the prayers we offer. Still, Adoration can be a powerful opportunity for transformative prayer. Adoration can involve any of the following prayers or meditations: Holy Hour, Rosary, Scripture Reading, Lectio Divina, etc.

You can also say this prayer: *My Lord Jesus Christ, it is your great love for us that keeps you day and night present in the Blessed Sacrament, full of compassion and love, waiting for us to visit you. I believe that you are really present in the Sacrament of the Altar. From the depth of my heart, I adore you and I thank you for the many graces you have given me, especially for the gift of yourself in this sacrament, for the gift of your most holy Mother as my Mother and for the privilege of visiting you in this church at this time. My Jesus, I love you with all my heart. I am sorry for my ingratitude and I now resolve, with the help of your grace, never to offend you again. I consecrate my entire self to you, my thoughts, my feelings, and all that I have. From now on, do whatever you want with me. All I ask for is your love and strength to do your holy will.*

# **The Year of Parish Revival**

## Experience the presence of Jesus during Adoration of the Eucharist

- Eucharistic Adoration involves exposing a consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, allowing people to sit and pray in the presence of Jesus Christ.
- In the presence of the Eucharist, we pray to the power and sacrifice that it represents — the body of Jesus, who gave His life so that we may have eternal life.
- Eucharistic adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist.
- Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the living God.
- Eucharistic adoration is a beautiful time to sit in silence with our Lord and spend time with Him, free from distraction.
- It is a good time to give thanks to the Lord for what He has done in our lives while looking at Him in the gift of the Eucharist.
- While it is true that you can pray to God anywhere and that He is always within you, it is especially powerful to adore Jesus in the Eucharist.
- How to prepare for Eucharistic adoration:
  - Sit quietly and listen or just enjoy being in the presence of Christ
  - Pray the Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet or any other favorite devotions
  - Focus on the mysteries of the rosary, the Passion of Christ, or a particular Scripture verse.
  - Write in your prayer journal. ...
  - Listen to praise and worship music through headphones.
  - Read a book by one of the saints (such as “The Diary of St. Faustina”)
- You can come for as long or short as you wish, but while you are there you can simply tell God how amazing He is.
- You don't have to say anything, you don't have to make sure you're "doing" adoration correctly. Instead, experience the joy of being with someone who wants to have a deep, intimate, friendship with you.
